in connection with the inquiry under this resolution, take 1 2 affidavits and depositions by a member, counsel, or consultant of the Committee, pursuant to notice or subpoena. 3 4 SEC. 3. (a) For the purpose of the inquiry under this 5 resolution, the Committee on the Judiciary is authorized 6 to require by subpoena or otherwise— 7 (1) the attendance and testimony of any person 8 (including at a taking of a deposition by counsel or 9 consultant of the Committee); and 10 (2) the production of such things; 11 as it deems necessary to such inquiry. (b) The Chairman of the Committee on the Judiciary, 12 after consultation with the Ranking Member, may exercise 13 the authority of the Committee under subsection (a). 14 15 (c) The Committee on the Judiciary may adopt a rule regulating the taking of depositions by a member, counsel, 16 17 or consultant of the Committee, including pursuant to subpoena. 18
